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| <p>Motor Vehicle Death Rate – Cumberland County</p> | <p>Data reviewed by committee. Mr. Crabtree to bring up for discussion at the Cumberland County Board of Health meeting. Amanda will ask coroner for updated (2018) data.</p> <p>Tracy Aaron reported that this has been presented at the Cumberland County health coalition meeting, but was not adopted as an action item by the group. Tracy reports that she will address this topic with ASAP group.</p> <p>Discussed creation of a FB/social media campaign to target Cumberland County in relation to this topic.</p> | <p>Mr. Crabtree will add to local Board of Health agenda for discussion.</p> <p>Health policy and Promotion staff will share findings with community coalitions and encourage local groups to adopt these issues and address them appropriately.</p> <p>Consider creation of social media campaign.</p> |
| <p>Teen Pregnancy Rate – McCreary County</p> | <p>Grants were submitted but LCDHD did not receive awards to address this topic.</p> | <p>Grants were not awarded to LCDHD - continue seeking additional grant funding.</p> |
| <p>School Immunization Rates – LCDHD Website</p> | <p>This is reportedly already improving. It was noted that Infinite Campus shows better numbers than the state reports for almost all schools (possibly due to IC being more “real time” reporting).</p> | <p>Continue to monitor.</p> |
| <p>Other Business</p> | <p>Mr. Crabtree added the data related to overdose related ER Admissions and Hospitalizations to the LCDHD website. Since then, 2017 data has been released and will be reviewed at the next data analysis committee meeting.</p> | <p>Committee will review 2017 data.</p> |

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| | SWOT Analysis – The District Board of Health and the LCDHD Staff have reviewed the 2017-2018 SWOT data. Weakness noted were: internal communication/staff unaware of programs (cross-promotion of programs planned). Opportunities noted were: faith-based partnerships, building additional partnerships with community stakeholders, technology development to engage more partners. | Several activities have already been built in to the agency’s strategic plan to address the issues noted in the SWOT. |
| | Updated/New Community Health Assessments have been completed for all 10 counties. Priority areas highlighted in the CHAs include: obesity, tobacco use, drug overdose, substance abuse, food insecurity, teen pregnancy. Data analysis committee will analyze this data in more depth at the next meeting when the Community Health Improvement Plans are completed and available. | Tracy Aaron will share CHAs and CHIPs with data analysis committee when available for review, prior to the next committee meeting. |
