<b>Welcome/Introductions</b>	<p>Senior Regional Epidemiologist, Amanda England, called the meeting to order at 10:00 AM ET.</p> <p>Review of previous meeting’s minutes. Amy Tomlinson made motion with Tracy Aaron second with minutes approved.</p>	
<b>Teen Pregnancy Rate – McCreary County</b>	<p>LCDHD received TPP grant for all 10 counties. McCreary and Casey County will implement teen outreach program in addition to high school education. The program will be after school. The schools will select high-risk students to participate in the program. There are student incentives and transportation provided to encourage participation. Coaching, mentoring, education, and community service learning are parts of the program. Pilot program in McCreary in March. The full program will begin August 2020.</p>	
<b>CHAs and CHIPs</b>	<p>Community assessments are finished for all ten counties. The CHA booklets are in the process of being edited and should be done by end of February 2020. The CHIPs are not completed, but should be done by end of this year.</p>	
<b>School Immunization Rates – LCDHD Website</b>	<p>The LCDHD website has state data but it did not correlate to local data. Schools share their data from Infinite Campus which is more accurate than state data. School immunization rates are reported on annual survey to schools. This is completed usually by school nurse or health coordinator and submitted to state. There was discussion on who sends out the survey</p>	<p>Laura will find out who at KDPH sends out school immunization surveys.</p>

<b>PHAB- Domain 3</b>	Janae brought examples from several health departments for PHAB-Domain 3.1.1.	Janae will review examples and get with Tracy and bring back to the committee to review.
<b>EmPOWER Data</b>	Amy discussed EmPOWER data, which includes Functional Access Needs (FAN) data, such as oxygen dependent individuals.	
<b>Social Vulnerability Data for Kentucky</b>	Amy shared Social Vulnerability website with the committee. Data such as minority, housing, and transportation are included in the online data. Amy discussed preparedness uses the data for plans. Transportation was an area of need in the district.	Tracy will reach out to LCADD and see if they are interested in writing grant to increase transportation availability in district.
<b>PHAB Population Health Outcomes Reporting</b>	LCDHD needed to monitor five health outcomes (in different categories). We have to indicate what we want to accomplish as well as SMART objective for each outcome. Some of these outcomes are being tracked in County Health Rankings. Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP) should include these requirements. Tobacco use and overdose deaths were two areas that were chosen to track. In the strategic plan, LCDHD is tracking tobacco use. For overdose hospitalization and death, we are utilizing KIPRIC data.

<p><b>Drug-Related Inpatient Hospitalizations and Emergency Department Visits</b></p>	<p>There was a media campaign for Taylor, Casey, and Pulaski. The reach was 53,489. This campaign included billboards and social media promoting Help Now with approved leftover grant money from KDPH.</p>	
<p><b>Health Report Card</b></p>	<p>The committee reviewed the online Health Report Card.</p> <p>There will be updated online analysis. Once the analysis is completed, the committee will meet again to discuss the findings.</p>	<p>Laura will look at chronic disease data and areas that need to be discussed and provide analysis.</p> <p>Amanda will look at infectious disease data and provide analysis.</p>
<p><b>Upcoming Training Opportunity</b></p>	<p>Training will be March 10, 2020 in Richmond regarding data analytics. Tracy Aaron and Janae Tucker are registered and will attend.</p>	
<p><b>Coronavirus</b></p>	<p>The committee discussed doing any promotion online of Coronavirus. There is currently a 2% mortality rate, as opposed to flu at 1% mortality rate. Information will be gathered to be placed online.</p>
