CHAs and CHIPs	<p>Community assessments are finished for all ten counties. The CHA booklets are in the process of being completed. The CHIPs are not completed, but should be done by end of this year.</p>	<p>Data Analysis will meet after CHIPs have been completed and will review plans.</p>

<p>School Immunization Rates – LCDHD Website</p>	<p>The LCDHD website has state data but it did not correlate to local data. Schools share their data from Infinite Campus which is more accurate than state data. Dr. Weyman reported 2017-2018, there was one school who had higher than 95% was Russell for 6th grade. For kindergarten schools who had higher than 95% was Russell, Pulaski, Taylor, and Wayne Counties.</p>	<p>Continue to monitor.</p>

Taylor and Casey County had the highest percentage of drug-related overdose hospitalizations and ER visits compared to population. They are however trending down. Pulaski County is trending up. Taylor County will be doing community education on syringe exchange and drug-related overdoses. The committee will look into doing media campaign for Taylor, Casey, and Pulaski.</p>	<p>Tracy is going to contact Jessica Gover to clarify if leftover grant money can be used for media campaign for Casey, Taylor, and Pulaski Counties.</p>
