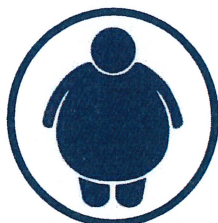

Adair County W.A.T.C.H. Coalition Vision Statement:

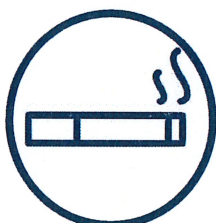
