<u>Adult Education</u> 2353 North Highway 127, Albany, KY Adult Education provides services such as adult education classes, GED preparation, family literacy instruction, English as a second language classes, workforce education and reading instruction for eligible Kentuckians.

Adanta Group Behavioral Services 101 Adanta Circle, Albany, KY provides individual and/or group family therapy, substance abuse counseling, marital counseling and psychiatric evaluation.

The Appalachian Research and Defense Fund of Kentucky, Inc (AppalReD) 301 Greensburg Street Columbia, KY provides free legal help for people and groups who cannot afford a private attorney. Children's health services include newborn screening, Well Child exams, fluoride varnishing, tuberculosis screenings, immunizations and lead screenings.
