HEALTH SUPPORT SERVICES

<u>Adult Education</u> 416 Scottsville St. Greensburg, KY. Adult Education provides services such as adult education classes, GED preparation, family literacy instruction, English as a second language classes, workforce education and reading instruction for eligible Kentuckians.

<u>Adanta Group Behavioral Services</u> provides individual and/or group family therapy, substance abuse counseling, marital counseling and psychiatric evaluation.

<u>Community Action Agency</u> Green County Courthouse, Greensburg, KY www.lc-caa.org Lake Cumberland Community Action Agency serves the ten counties in the Lake Cumberland region providing heating, cooling, emergency food and shelter assistance to qualified individuals and families.

The Division of Protection and Permanency provides adoption counseling, foster care services, emergency

Maternity clothes, baby food and formula are all given freely to the participants of the Hope Program.
