Adult Education 416 Scottsville St. Greensburg, KY. Adult Education provides services such as adult education classes, GED preparation, family literacy instruction, English as a second language classes, workforce education and reading instruction for eligible Kentuckians.

Adanta Group Behavioral Services provides individual and/or group family therapy, substance abuse counseling, marital counseling and psychiatric evaluation.

The Division of Protection and Permanency provides adoption counseling, foster care services, emergency shelter care, family counseling and protective service investigations of adults and children.

Hope Pregnancy Center 319 East Maple Street Campbellsville, KY www.hopepc.org The Central Kentucky Pregnancy Crisis Center offers the following free services: pregnancy testing, peer support group, adoption information, post abortion peer support groups and peer support counseling. Maternity clothes, baby food and formula are all given freely to the participants of the Hope Program.

Ministerial Association - the Ministerial Association offers food, medical assistance, utility and temporary lodging assistance to families in need.

Green County Health Department 220 Industrial Park Greensburg, KY- Your local Health Department provides community-based health initiatives and preventive health care services to the residents of your county. Adult health services include family planning (birth control), WIC (Women, Infants & Children food program), medical nutrition therapy, grief counseling, tuberculosis screenings, STD and HIV screenings, diabetes screening and counseling, immunizations and breast and cervical cancer screenings. Children's health services include newborn screening, Well Child exams, fluoride varnishing, tuberculosis screenings, immunizations and lead screenings.
