<u>Adult Education</u> 848 West Steve Warriner Dr. Russell Springs, KY. Adult Education provides services such as adult education classes, GED preparation, family literacy instruction, English as a second language classes, workforce education and reading instruction for eligible Kentuckians.

Adanta Group Behavioral Services 119 Herrifords Cir, Jamestown, KY provides individual and/or group family therapy, substance abuse counseling, marital counseling and psychiatric evaluation.
