<u>Adult Education</u> 1311 E. Broadway, Suite C, Campbellsville, KY. Adult Education provides services such as adult education classes, GED preparation, family literacy instruction, English as a second language classes, workforce education and reading instruction for eligible Kentuckians.

<u>Adanta Group Behavioral Services</u> 250 Watertower Bypass, Campbellsville, KY 42718 provides individual and/or group family therapy, substance abuse counseling, marital counseling and psychiatric evaluation.

The Appalachian Research and Defense Fund of Kentucky, Inc (AppalReD) 301 Greensburg Street Columbia, KY provides free legal help for people and groups who cannot afford a private attorney.
