Top Sources of Health Information:

1. Healthcare providers (65.4%)
2. Internet (41.3%)
3. Public health officials (35.6%)
4. Friends/family (35.6%)
5. Social media (26.9%)



Top Risk Factors in Casey County:

1. Substance misuse (45.2%)
2. Lack of a livable wage (39.4%)
3. Housing Insecurity (31.7%)
4. Inadequate health insurance (30.8%)
5. Poor eating habits (29.8%)

Top Strengths of the Community:

1. Religious/Spiritual Values (35.6%)
2. Access to health care (31.7%)
3. Strong family life (27.9%)
4. Good place to raise children (26.0%)
5. Good schools (24.0%)



Most Important Health Problems:

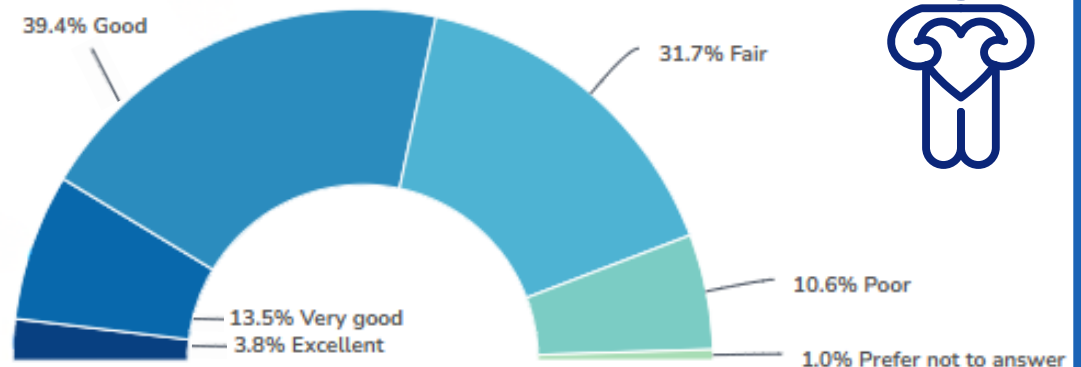
1. Overdose (48.1%)

5. Utilities (20.2%)



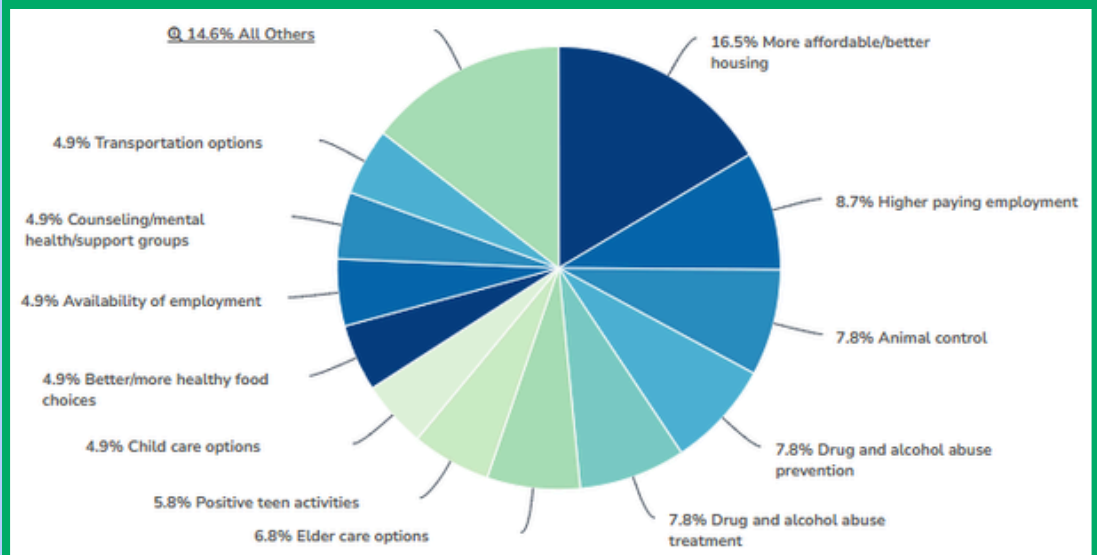
58.6% were satisfied that the health department has made a positive impact
