Adult Education 690 S. Wallace Wilkinson Blvd. Liberty, KY. Adult Education provides services such as adult education classes, GED preparation, family literacy instruction, English as a second language classes, workforce education and reading instruction for eligible Kentuckians.

Adanta Group Behavioral Services 322 Middleburg Street Liberty, KY provides individual and/or group family therapy, substance abuse counseling, marital counseling and psychiatric evaluation.

The Appalachian Research and Defense Fund of Kentucky, Inc (AppalReD) 301 Greensburg Street Columbia, KY provides free legal help for people and groups who cannot afford a private attorney. Services include: fight foreclosure and unfair home loans, social security and SSI, unemployment compensation, tenant-landlord disputes, fight evictions, public housing, KTAP/food stamps, Medicare/Medicaid, disability rights, bankruptcy, consumer protection, family law, employment discrimination, school/education, senior citizens' rights, civil rights and tax problems.

Adult health services include family planning (birth control), WIC (Women, Infants & Children food program), medical nutrition therapy, grief counseling, tuberculosis screenings, STD and HIV screenings, diabetes screening and counseling, immunizations and breast and cervical cancer screenings. Children's health services include newborn screening, Well Child exams, fluoride varnishing, tuberculosis screenings, immunizations and lead screenings.
